

Parallel Circuit proudly announces its participation in "8Fair 2025 > Episode 02". The fair will take place from November 21 to December 5, 2025 at 8cube Gallery, where Parallel Circuit will present a curated selection of artworks by a dynamic group of artists: Bita Fayyazi, Andisheh Avini, Homa Delvaray, and Mamali Shafahi. The presentation focuses on dimensions and depth, not only as spatial concerns, but as ways of thinking about time, narrative, memory, and the art medium itself.

Parallel Circuit's presentation in Episode 02 extends this trajectory into a more explicitly multi-dimensional space. The booth is conceived as a field of shifting planes and viewpoints: surfaces that behave like volumes, sculptural forms that carry the memory of images and histories.

Homa Delvaray's works grow out of typographies that have taken on volume and are rendered in an isometric perspective that recalls various schools of Iranian miniature painting. These posters often weave together ornament, script, geometry, and color to construct complex structures that function like architectures on paper or textile: grids that tilt, spiral, or fold inward, creating on the picture plane a sense of thresholds and inner courtyards. In this presentation, Delvaray's works pose the question of how a "flat surface" can, at the same time, hold multiple dimensions within itself, inviting the viewer to read the image in successive layers.

Mamali Shafahi whose practice shifts between video, installation, sculpture, and painting, pushes the notion of depth into the realm of relief images and speculative

worlds. In his recent works, painted surfaces become volumetric elements: protrusions rise from the canvas, turning into autonomous forms that pull the image toward the viewer. Shafahi's interest in virtuality, memory, and intergenerational narratives adds yet another layer of depth to his work.

Bita Fayyazi's installations often fill a space with animal, human, or hybrid figures, creating environments that carry a theatrical atmosphere subtly embedded in the room. Bodies appear in states of suspension, vulnerability, or transformation, forming layered scenes that the viewer must physically move through in space.

In this conversation around depth and scale, Andy Avini's glass balls introduce a more understated but incisive gesture: they refuse the usual trick of enlargement or miniaturization and remain at the same hand-held size as the inexpensive toy balls they recall. The shift, instead, occurs in material and framing. What was once light, disposable plastic reappears as dense, fragile glass that gathers reflections, distortions, and passing light inside its small volume. Each sphere becomes a compact lens through which the surrounding space, the viewer's body,

and the memory of a shared, low-cost childhood object are folded together. In the context of this booth, Avini's works extend the presentation's inquiry into depth by showing how a familiar, "life-sized" object can contain multiple temporal and emotional registers at once—surface play and latent vulnerability, private nostalgia and collective memory—without ever changing its physical scale.



Homa Delvaray (b. 1980, Tehran, Iran) is an Iranian graphic designer and visual artist living and working in Tehran. Since earning a degree in Visual Communication from the University of Tehran (2006), she has extended her work across a variety of mediums, from installation to sculpture, textile art to artist book.

Her practice activates the overlap of graphic and stage design in a spatial framework. Her works, often presented as an installation of a group of objects, engages the architectural space using a combination of design and spatial strategies. A graphic designer by training Delvaray employs the tools she has at her disposal to research and present what she observes as the paradoxical life within the dichotomies found in the life of contemporary Iranians. Her recent series investigates gender relations and how it has been formulated in mythological metaphors and tropes.



Mamali Shafahi (b. 1982, based in Paris and Tehran) is a filmmaker and visual artist known for his immersive, mixed-media installations that combine sound and light to create visual feasts adorned with enigmatic chimeras that defy categorization. His works reflect the complexities of cultural diversity and identity, shattering stereotypes and inviting viewers to explore the richness beneath the surface. Rooted in his Iranian heritage, they offer an escape into realms of fantasy, seamlessly blending the magical with the terrifying, and fantasy with horror, all within a mesmerizing world of optical illusions. As part of his long-term project Daddy Sperm, Shafahi created the experimental docu-fiction film Nature Morte, featuring his parents. This work became the backbone of an installation at City Princes/ses at the Palais de Tokyo in Paris in 2019. His VR collaboration with Ali Eslami, nerd_funk, has been showcased at Het Nieuwe Instituut (Rotterdam), the Vancouver Biennale, and IDFA, earning the Golden Calf for Best Interactive Film at the Netherlands Film Festival. Following this success, he was a guest resident at the Rijksakademie in Amsterdam. In 2024, Shafahi embarked on a collaboration with his partner Domenico Gutknecht (b. 1987), titled Rest in Peace, further expanding his multidisciplinary practice.





Mamali Shafahi. "Celestial Baby". 2025 Flocked epoxy clay. 40 x 45 x 44 cm. Unique edition

Bita Fayyazi (b. 1962, Tehran) lives and works in Tehran. More than a sculptor, an installation artist, or ceramicist, engaged in some mystic relationship with her material, Fayyazi is an artist who works within a more performative and markedly social practice.

Bita Fayyazi struggled to show her work amidst an atmosphere of stuffy traditionalism, academicism, and the influx of 1990s conceptual art. Beginning in mid-1990s, her artistic interventions challenged the official definitions of art. Works of Fayyazi are collaborative by nature. She and her artist or non-artist colleagues use whatever material is readily available to wrap and entwine, paint and cast sculptures made of the fabric of social participation. She reconstitutes the energies of the many toward an uncertain resolution. The final object becomes less important than the process – the collective doing, the love of doing – that preceded its creation.



Andisheh Avini (b. 1974, New York) is an artist who uses painting, drawing, printmaking, and sculpture, often incorporating the traditional craft of marquetry in his artistic practice.

Andisheh Avini explores the duality of his own identity by combining iconic images like Persian calligraphy, decorative motifs, and portraiture with occidental concepts of minimalism and abstraction. Avini's approach speaks to a larger globalized society of nomads, the displaced, and the wayfarer, reflecting a contemporary multicultural experience to which many can relate.
